 - Kiln



Reuse

- Reuse Opportunities
 - All incoming packaged products are broken down into reusable bins
 - ▶ 1. Bubble wrap placed into community bins Savings since 2014 \$ 12,240
 - ▶ 2. Inserts placed onto community carts for associate access - Savings since 2014 -\$14,400
 - ▶ 3. Cardboard boxes placed into boxes holders after all labels have been covered for reuse - Savings since 2014 - \$60,600



Reuse Continued

- ► Pallets all incoming products are shipped from other Timken facilities on wooden pallets. Savings since 2014 \$155,712
 - Size
 - **▶** Condition
- Rust Preventative Oil used to inhibit corrosion on finished product. Savings since 2010 - \$72,672
 - ► Filter
 - ► Evaluate
