Stakeholder Process

Representatives participated in work group
beginning 2016

Bill introduced 2018

House Bill H. 4644 effective May 2018

SECTION 44-96-360. Solid waste processing facilities.

Changes Effective May 3, 2018.

Unpermitted C&D Facilities

- must register within sixty days of the effective date of the amendment; and
- submit a complete permit application within twelve months
- obtain a permit within twenty-four months,
- or, close in accordance with R. 61-107.6

Permit Exemptions

- materials segregated from solid waste and sorted at generation; and
- 75% by weight of each material is used, reused, recycled, or transferred to a different site for use, reuse, or recycling; and
- the material is managed to demonstrate value.
- Existing facilities ≤ 2 acres that recycle 75% by weight

Registered Facility Reporting Requirements

Registered facilities must submit an annual report, including:

- total weight of each material received during calendar year;
- total weight of each material remaining from last year;
- total weight of material used or transferred during calendar year; and
- total weight solid waste removed and disposed during the calendar year, and location disposed.

Regulation 61-107.6
