- Tours of their construction and demolition landfill, transfer station, and wood grinding facility

Traude serves on CRA's Education and Outreach Committee, the Midlands Green Business program, the Environmental Education Association of SC and the SC Green Step Schools Initiative.

Last year the county contracted curbside collection for almost 30,000 households, operated 11 manned convenience centers serving 2 million vehicles, and coordinated 6 special drop-off events serving over 2,000 residents. Traude Sander is a force behind making recycling a success story in Lexington County!
