- Molded natural fiber/paper products uncoated with any sort of plastic film
- Purchasing post-consumer recycled content is a plus
- Items include napkins, food boats, plates, or to-go boxes, etc.

Beginning Problems

- Problems that arise in Wilmington:
 - Outside food trucks
 - ► Compostable plastics melt in the hot sun
- Solutions in the works:
 - Approaching food trucks
 - ► TURN reusable cup system







Life cycle of compostable plastics at concerts: Middle



- Educating consumers that their cups are compostable
 - Word of mouth
 - Signage

Life cycle of compostable plastics at concerts: End

- Sorting
 - Many cups still get mixed in recycling
 - My team sorts them out stacks them in containers
- ► Containers are serviced by WCC after every show
- WCC brings the concert compost waste to
 - New Hanover County Composter
 - "in vessel" method of composting
 - Piney Run Farms
- Quality of material
 - ► Feedback: They don't see much contamination
 - ▶ 10% contamination rate

Conclusion

- At Live Nation, we measure sustainability success using diversion rates.
- ▶ 2021 Show Day Diversion Rates
 - ~79% at Greenfield Lake Amphitheater
 - ▶ 68% at Live Oak Bank Pavilion
 - ► Composted 7,000 pounds, recycled 49,460 pounds, donated 518 pounds, landfilled 26,360 pounds
- ▶ 2022 Show Day Diversion Rates
 - ▶ 85% at Greenfield Lake Amphitheater
 - ► Composted 6,685 pounds, recycled 35,321 pounds, donated 65 pounds
 - > 73% at Live Oak Bank Pavilion
 - ► Composted 18,690 pounds, recycled 31,742 pounds, donated 1,194 pounds
