Burgundy Zone Project

Aimed at addressing microaggressions and ableism towards individuals with disabilities.

What did we do?

- **Sent out a survey to the student body**
- **Collected results**
- **Created a program to present to faculty addressing the concerns**



What Did We Find?

- 1. Most of the people who took the survey identified as an individual with a disability.**
- 1. All of the individuals who took the survey identified concerns about inaccessibility.**
- 1. There were multiple recurring problems.**



What is Next?

- **Creating an educational training program**
- **Expanding the Accessibility Office to handle further concerns**
- **Ensuring the program is continued each year**
